# CAR ACCIDENT CHECKLIST



### **ENSURE SAFETY**

#### 1. Move to a safe location

If possible, move your vehicle out of traffic to prevent further accidents.

If you can't move off the highway/roadway, it is imperative to remain in your vehicle, for safety reasons, until emergency services are on scene.

Turn on hazard lights: Activate your vehicle's hazard lights to signal that you're in distress.

### 2. Assess yourself

and others involved for injuries.

### 3. Call 911

or emergency services immediately if anyone is injured or if there's significant damage.

## **COLLECT INFORMATION**

### 4. Exchange Information

Exchange contact and insurance information with the other driver(s) involved. This typically includes names, phone numbers, addresses, driver's license numbers, and insurance policy details. Note the make, model, and license plate numbers of all vehicles involved.

### 5. Document the Scene

Take photos and videos of the accident scene, including vehicle damage, road conditions, traffic signs, and the positions of the vehicles. Collect witness information, if possible, by obtaining names and contact details from anyone who saw the accident.
